

# Human Trafficking in Maine: Identification and Response Training

Maine's local multidisciplinary anti-trafficking teams offer this statewide training, which is victim-centered and empowerment-based, and features interactive, skills-building sessions informed by Maine-based expertise and resources.

The training is offered at no cost by trained social service and health care providers and law enforcement officers.

## Standard Training (2 hours)

Human trafficking overview, featuring Maine-based data regarding prevalence, dynamics of trafficking, indicators, and best practice response.

Participants will:

- Increase their understanding of the problem of human trafficking in Maine;
- Learn how to identify victims/survivors of human trafficking; and
- Learn how to meet the needs of trafficking victims/survivors using multidisciplinary response, which is the model most widely used in Maine.

## Condensed Overview (45 Minutes)
